Transportation of Youths Policy

Sherwood Cricket Club has a policy relating to transporting children to and from matches and training. It should be noted that Parents / Carers are responsible for the safe delivery and collection of their child for matches or training whether these are at our home ground or away from the Club.

At the start of year / season a meeting will be held to distribute information relating to all planned away fixtures or competitions to provide Parents / Carers with an opportunity to make appropriate arrangements.

Coaches and Club Staff will only be responsible for the Children in their care when on the Club premises or on arrival at opponents' cricket grounds.

It is **not** the responsibility of the Coach or Team Manager to transport, or arrange to transport, the children to and from the Club or match.

The Club must receive permission from Parents/Carers for children to participate in all competitions and away fixtures / events.

It is recommended that Players are dropped off at the Club a minimum of 45 minutes prior to the start of a match. This will assist us in preparation of the pitch and provide sufficient time for changing and a team briefing.

In addition, children should be picked up from the Club 45 minutes after play has ceased. For most Youth games, this will be approximately 3 hours from the start of play. Should a game take significantly less time than originally expected the Team Coach and/or Manager may inform you via your contact numbers to collect your child earlier.

For all home games the pickup point will be in the Club House at Sherwood Cricket Club.
